



## Mr. Louis Gene Beaudoin

July 10, 1928 - September 9, 2014

L. Gene Beaudoin, 86, of Lake Keowee passed away September 9, 2014. He was born July 10, 1928 in Iron Mountain, Michigan, son of Elsie & Louis.

He was a dedicated educator for most of his working life, graduating from Northern Michigan University and gaining his masters degree at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor in Education and Psychology.

Most of his high school administrative career was spent at Mundelein High School in Illinois, where he served as Guidance Director and Assistant Superintendent. He also served at the DAVEA Center in Wheaton, IL.

Moving to Keowee Key in 1988 under the guise of retirement from the Illinois school system, Gene continued working in education in the Oconee County school system and at the Tri County Technical College in Pendleton. He also put in stints with the lesser- understood arts of automotive sales and pontoon boat repair before finally retiring officially in 1999.

Gene loved to snow ski, competing at the collegiate level and on the US Army Ski Team while stationed in Germany. He was a dedicated fly fisherman, tennis and racquetball player, runner, golfer and swimmer. He also had a long history of riding motorcycles, some more respectable than others. He had a great sense of humor and loved one-liners, Calvin & Hobbes and deadpan

delivery. He would try to build or repair anything and was a skilled metalworker and woodworker.

He was preceded in death by his much-loved wife of 57 years, Ann in 2011. He leaves behind two children, Cathy and Chris, and two grandchildren, Greg and Jasmine. He is also survived by his brother Wallace and family in Michigan.
