August 19, 1915 - December 25, 2009

Emma Lucile Abbott Harper, 94, wife of the late Louis Kahn Harper, formerly of 165 Letson Circle, Walhalla, SC, died Friday, December 25, 2009 at Lila Doyle Nursing Care Facility.

A native of Walhalla, Mrs. Harper was the daughter of the late Glenn Davis and Nan Farmer Abbott. She was a member of the family of Harper's 5 & 10 Stores. Mrs. Harper was a member of the Walhalla Presbyterian Church where she served as a Sunday School Teacher and was a member of the Women of the Church and the Haynes Circle. She was a member of the Walhalla Pilot Club, the Daughters of the American Revolution, Walhalla Garden Club, and was a former Chairman of the Oconee County Cripple Childrens Society.

Mrs. Harper is survived by sons: Glenn Earle Harper of Montgomery, AL, John Marshall Harper of Walhalla, SC and Richard Alexander Harper of Salem, SC; daughter: Nancy Harper Lanford of Philipsburg, MT; sister: Deane Wells of Pickens, SC; ten grandchildren and sixteen great grandchildren.
