Lucille Hughes Chambers, 91, died unexpectedly on December 30, 2017, after a long illness.

She was born September 21, 1926, in Greensboro, North Carolina, and was the daughter of the late Fannie Mae and James Clarence Hughes.

Lucille married James Charles Chambers July 16, 1944, and celebrated 47 years of marriage. They had two sons, James Michael and Jeffrey Dale. She retired as an Executive Secretary from National Data Corporation and enjoyed painting, ceramics, scrapbooking and creating an ancestry history for family members.
