Marcus Barak Sanders, 74, husband of Geraldine Quarles Sanders, of 221 W. Halfway Branch Road, Walhalla, SC, died Thursday, August 18, 2011 at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Sanders was the son of the late Marvin and Bonnie Lee Sanders. He was retired from Schlumberger after twenty-six years of service.
