



## Margaret Winnifred Kent-Faiola

Margaret (Marnie) Winifred Gittings Kent-Faiola, wife of John Arthur Faiola, Col. USA (Ret), of 17008 Beckwell Drive, Seneca, SC, died Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Puslinch Ontario, Canada, Mrs. Faiola was the daughter of the late Albert and Lucy Ann Maddox Gittings. After Mrs. Faiola retired from Campbell-Ewald, an advertising agency of the Interpublic Group, she was a volunteer at the Emergency Waiting Room at William Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak, Michigan; a volunteer for the Oakland County Hospice Program, and was the Bereavement Group Facilitator at St. James Episcopal Church, Birmingham, Michigan. She also served with the Canadian Red Cross in World War II. In addition, she and her late husband, E. R. Kent, were lay readers at the St. Stephens Episcopal Church, Troy, Michigan.

When Mrs. Faiola and her husband John came to Seneca, she was an eight year volunteer at the Oconee Memorial Hospital Surgical Waiting Room. She was memorialized with a Labor & Delivery Suite, and a suite in the Critical Care Unit in the New Patient Tower, Oconee Medical Center.

Mrs. Faiola was a member of the Lake District Chapter of the Daughters of the British Empire. She was also a member of the Seneca Women's Club.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Faiola is survived by son, John Paul Kent of West Bloomfield, MI; daughter, Pamela Jayne Jalkanen of Bloomfield Hills, MI; four grandsons, Robert T. Kent, John Paul Kent, Jr., Dustin Kent Christie, Nicholas Paul Christie, and Pamela's Springer Spaniel "Lacie".

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Faiola was predeceased by three brothers, and two sisters.
