Marion Hurlbut Riggs, 90, wife of the late Kenneth F. Riggs, died Thursday, June 14, 2012 at Lila Doyle Nursing Facility.

A native of Torrington, CT, Mrs. Riggs was the daughter of the late Ernest and Gertrude Crutch Hurlbut. She was a homemaker and of the Episcopal faith. She was a 50 year member and Past Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star. Mrs. Riggs lived in Greensboro, NC for thirty years. She was a member of the St. Andrews Episcopal Church where she served as President of the Episcopal Church Women. She also performed extensive volunteer work for the American Red Cross.

Mrs. Riggs is survived by a son, James K. Riggs of Charlotte, NC; daughters, Janet R. Jerome (William) of Salem, SC, and Phyllis R. Curtis (The Rev.
