Marshall Thomas Smith, 98, of 91 Penny Lane, York, PA, and husband of the late Ruth Butts Tomlin Phillips Smith, passed away Monday, May 15, 2017, at in York, PA.

A native of West Union, SC, Mr. Smith was born to Ulysses T. and Ollie Jane Abbott Smith on September 27, 1918. He was a graduate of Clemson University with a B.S. Degree in Mechanical Engineering. Mr. Smith served in the U.S. Army in Italy during the WWII and was awarded the Bronze Star. He retired from the U.S. Army with the rank of Lt. Col. Mr. Smith retired from his concurrent civilian occupation as Aberdeen Proving Grounds in Maryland as a Mechanical Engineer in 1976. He was a life member of the V.F.W, the Retired Officers Association and Pleasant Ridge Baptist Church.

Mr. Smith is survived by his sons: Dr. Thomas David Smith (Anna) of York, PA and Rodney Wike Smith (Mary Katherine) of Elliston, VA; step-daughters: Paula Ridley (John) and Barbara Rogers (John) of TX; brother: Charles Edward Smith of Richmond, VA; sister: Betty Ann Smith Moore of Seattle, WA, four grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren and five step-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
