Martha Alice Aly, 84, of 106 Windsong Way, Seneca, passed away Sunday, November 20, 2016, at her home.

A native of Bonne Terre, MO, Ms. Aly was the daughter of the late Dr. Bower and Adelaide Johnson Aly, and step mother Dr. Lucile F. Aly. She graduated from University High School, Columbia, MO, in 1949, then graduated with her Bachelor's Degree from University of Missouri, in 1952, and later graduated with her Master's Degree from University of Illinois, in 1959. She went on to work as a high school teacher in Burlington, Iowa and Galveston, TX; a professor at Kansas State University, University of Illinois, and Clemson University. Ms. Aly also worked as an administrator for the Maryland State Department of Education, and Prince George's County Public Schools.

Ms. Aly is survived by her brothers: Charles E. Aly (Domenica) and Stewart F. Aly (Carla); sister: Barbara A. Miller; fourteen nieces and nephews; and twelve great nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents and step mother, Ms. Aly was preceded in death by her brother: John Aly; sister: Joanna A. Gray; and brother-in-law: Robert Miller.
