Max Wigington, 77, of 341 Sandy Hill Drive, Seneca, husband of Sandy Wilson Wigington, passed away on Friday, November 22, 2013 at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Salem, SC, Mr. Wigington was the son of the late Christine Elizabeth McCall, and Oscar Wigington. He was the owner/operator of Wigington, Inc. and was a member of Utica Baptist Church. Mr. Wigington was a former member of the School Board of Oconee County, Oconee Historical Society, and the Clemson University Pershing Rifles. He enjoyed collecting antique cars, crafting stained glass, and wine making.
