Mildred Adeline Rutledge, 92, died peacefully Monday, May 26, 2008 at Palmetto Health Baptist Hospital in Easley.

A native of Walhalla, Miss Rutledge was the daughter of the late John Jay and Gertrude Cantrell Rutledge. She was a retired employee of the US Treasury, having served in North and South America, Africa, Asia, and the Caribbean. Miss Rutledge was the author of Experiences of a U.S. Government Working Stiff which recounts her experiences in many different parts of the world. She was a member of Bethel Presbyterian Church and was the last surviving member of her immediate family.
