### OTTO ELBERT BROOKS

Mr. Otto E. Brooks, Jr. (80), husband of Eve Shields Brooks of 11 Sextant Drive, Salem, SC, died Sunday, April 6, 2008 at Saint Frances Hospital in Greenville, SC.

Mr. Brooks was born in Los Angeles, California, August 25, 1927 to the late Otto E. Brooks, Sr. and Irene Olga Bach. He graduated from Venice High School and attended classes at Santa Monica City College and the University of California at Los Angeles. He was employed by Allied Signal Aerospace (now Honeywell) and retired after 43 years of service as Manager of Contracts from their AiResearch Los Angeles Division. In retirement he was an active traveler and sportsman. Mr. Brooks was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Ascension, the Keowee Key Country Club and was a veteran of the U.S. Navy.

Mr. Brooks was predeceased by his wife of 50 years, Virginia Lee Robb.
