Salem, SC—Paul Joseph Power, 84, of 1 Spinnaker Way, Salem, SC died Tuesday, March 18, 2008 at Oconee Memorial Hospital after a lengthy illness. He was born in Newton, MA, the son of the late Paul Power, Sr. and Eunice Quinn Power. He spent his childhood in Arlington, MA and lived in Wellesley, MA for 22 years before retiring to Keowee Key in Salem, SC.

Mr. Power was a 1st Lieutenant in the Marine Corps during World War II. He then graduated from Boston University in 1947. He was Branch Manager of Shaw Walker in Hartford, CT, Sales Manager of Xerox in Boston and Vice-President of Network Systems Design in Boston.

Mr. Power is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, Mary-Jane Donovan Power. He is also survived by two daughters and three sons-in-law: Rosemary Power Carlson and husband, Gilbert Carlson of Fredericksburg, VA; Susan Power Fernandez and husband, Dr. Francisco Fernandez of Tampa, FL; and David Kent of Milford, MA. He is also survived by a brother, John Power and wife, Paula of Lexington, MA; a sister, Jane McMahon and husband, Edwin of Florida; and six grandsons.

He was predeceased by two loving daughters, Katy Power Kent and Mary-Ellen Power.

Mr. Power was an avid Petanque player and loved the game and the friends who challenged him.

A memorial mass will be celebrated at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church in Seneca, SC on Thursday at 10:30 a.m.
