Rev. Dr. Robert Harold Thompson, II, 65, of Hiddenite, NC passed away unexpectedly at his residence on Sunday, November 8, 2009. He was born October 6, 1944 to Robert Harold Thompson, Sr. and Lola Pickett Thompson in Eleria, OH. Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Elizabeth Thompson.

Bob was a member of Reformation Lutheran Church. He was a graduate of Pfeiffer University, received his Masters of Divinity from Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary, and his Doctor of Ministry from Union Theological Seminary of Richmond, VA. He was a retired minister. During his ministry years he served as pastor at Reformation Lutheran in Taylorsville, St. John Lutheran in Walhalla, SC, St. Peter Lutheran in Chapin, SC, and Ehrhardt Lutheran Parish in Ehrhardt, SC. He served as USC Lutheran Campus Pastor and Professor of Religion at USC Salkehatchie. Also, he was a reserve officer for the Ehrhardt/Denmark Police Department.
