Rhett Dendy Rogers, 95, husband of the late Frances Williams Rogers of Seneca, SC, passed away Wednesday, October 28, 2015, at Greer Memorial Hospital.

A native of Oconee County, SC, Mr. Rogers was the son of the late Truman A. Rogers and Myrtle Mae Miller Rogers. He retired from Southern Bell and volunteered at the Shriners Children's Hospital of Greenville, SC. Mr. Rogers was a member of Trinity Baptist Church, the Seneca Masonic Lodge, and the Hejaz Shrine Temple. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, and was a member of the Seneca American Legion Post #120.

Mr. Rogers is survived by a daughter: Anne Williams (Rick) of Greer; two grandchildren: Katy Caldwell (Eric) and Mark Williams (Ginny); and five great-grandchildren. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.
