Richard Eugene Kulper, 79, husband of Peggy Kulper, of 152 South Oak Pointe Drive, Seneca, South Carolina, passed away at his home on November 15, 2022.

A native of Newark, New Jersey, Richard was the son of the late Gene and Lorraine Levy Kulper. He is predeceased by a brother, Ronald Kulper and a sister, Nancy Carrick.

Mr. Kulper is survived by four children: Jennifer (Tom) Wright, of Richmond, Virginia, James Gibson, of Atlanta, Georgia, Janice (Marc) Westfall of Wayesville, Ohio, and Richard (Gretchen) Kulper, Jr. of Blue Ash, Ohio. He has three grandchildren: Sydney Herres, Gracie Westfall, and Ian Wright and great-grandson, Jameson Herres. He is survived by one sister, Maryann (Mark) Spatola of Wilmington, North Carolina.

Mr. Kulper worked for the same company throughout his career: Emery that is now BASF. He retired as director of purchasing in December, 1999.

While working full time and having a family, Richard graduated from Rutgers and Farleigh Dickinson Universities with a master's degree in business administration.

Mr. Kulper lived in Newark and East Brunswick, New Jersey, Simpsonville, South Carolina, Cincinnati, Ohio, and Seneca, South Carolina.

From 2005-2015 Richard was volunteer director of Golden Corner Food Pantry. With the help of committed volunteers, he developed the agency into one that is still making a big impact for Oconee County residents. A permanent facility was built and a program for seniors was developed.

Mr. Kulper was a member of Eternal Shephard Lutheran Church. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army. He was active in many newcomer groups, loved playing cards, was an excellent bowler, and loved gardening.
