Rev. Robert Lee Harden, 96, husband of the late Edith Moore Harden, of 661 Earles Grove Road, Westminster, passed away Monday, March 27, 2017, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Oakway, SC, Rev. Harden was the son of the late John Lewis and Bertha Hall Harden. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. Rev. Harden was a Pastor for 35 years, serving 10 years at Cheohee Baptist Church and later attended Ebenezer Baptist Church.
