



Captain Robert E. Miale, USN (RET.)

February 12, 1931 - January 22, 2014

Captain Robert E. Miale, 82, husband of Susan Beecher Morgan Miale (his once-in-a-lifetime love) of 304 Cedar Post Court, Seneca, SC, passed away Wednesday, January 22, 2014 at Cottingham Hospice House, Seneca, SC.

A native of Rochester, NY, Captain Miale was the son of August and Nina Galli Miale. He was graduated from Heidelberg College with the degree Bachelor of Arts in 1952. He served as a surface warfare officer and in various other positions in the U.S. Navy from 1952 until his retirement in 1979. His major sea command was the U.S.S. WILLIAM H. STANDLEY (CG 32).

Captain Miale also coined the long-time navy slogan, "Navy. It's not just a job; It's an adventure."

During his Navy career, Captain Miale was awarded the Legion of Merit with gold stars in lieu of a second and third award, the Meritorious Service Medal, and the Navy Commendation Medal.

After Captain Miale retired, he and Susan moved to South Central Virginia where they finished the restoration of an 1859 farm house. They have lived in the Seneca area since 2009.

In addition to his wife, Captain Miale is survived by a son, Robert Miale

(Angela) of Monroe, GA; daughters, Lisa Yenowine (David) of Powder Springs and Victoria Luzader (Robert) of Charlottesville, VA; brother, August Miale, Jr. (Patricia) of Fort Lauderdale; six grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 AM, Saturday, February 1, 2014, at Davenport Funeral Home Chapel, Walhalla, SC. The burial will be at Arlington National Cemetery, Washington, DC

The family will receive friends following the service at Cliffabee Leas Clubhouse.
