Robert Newmark, 80, of 123 Starboard Tack Drive, Salem, SC, husband of Linda Sims Newmark, died Sunday, December 18, 2011 at his residence.

A native of Vienna, Austria, he was the son of the late Karl and Amelia Berdick Neumark. He had several hobbies; fishing, golfing, traveling, sports, and loved playing card and board games. He had a love for animals. He enjoyed riding and broke wild horses at ranches in Colorado and always had many dogs, cats, and birds as pets. Mr. Newmark lettered in four sports in high school and went on to play Navy Football.

Bob was a dedicated career man. He started his career at Honeywell in Anaheim, CA and over twenty plus years, worked his way up the ladder to the Board of Vice Presidents. He was recognized for his success and was recruited to join the Board of Vice Presidents of Emerson Electric in St. Louis, MO.
