



Mr. Ronald August Bode

January 10, 1942 - September 7, 2023

Ronald August Bode, 81, husband of Marilyn Jean Stordahl Bode, of West Union, passed away on Thursday, September 7, 2023, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Wood Lake, Minnesota, he was the son of the late Erwin Christian and Edna Engel Bode. Mr. Bode was a United States Marine Corps Vietnam Veteran helicopter pilot who was awarded twenty-eight air medals throughout his career. He retired from a civilian career in corrugated paper manufacturing and attended Eternal Shepherd Lutheran Church.

In addition to his wife of 52 years, Mr. Bode is survived by his daughters: Tristan Patrick (Wes) of Lexington, SC; Janene Hill (Todd) of Mt.
