Roy Hayne Thrasher, 90, husband of the late Bonnie Sue Davis, of 185 Thrasher Lane, Seneca, passed away Friday, October 9, 2020, at his home.

A native of Townville, SC, Mr. Thrasher was the son of the late Henry Hayne and Zela Boggs Thrasher. He retired from Phillips Fibers.
