



## Ruby Chastain Hinkle

July 11, 1913 - May 18, 2012

Ruby Chastain Hinkle, 98, of Salem, SC, wife of the late Horace Hinkle, died Friday, May 18, 2012 at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Oconee County, SC, Mrs. Hinkle was the daughter of the late John Lewis and Janie Elizabeth Gaston Chastain. She was a homemaker and a member of Salem First Baptist Church. She was also a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Joyful Daughters Sunday School Class. Mrs. Hinkle worked faithfully in Baptist Young Pupils Union, Bible School, and taught Sunday school for 70 years.
