Sarah Frances Wall Duvall, 78, wife of Julius Dean Duvall, of Seneca, passed away on Monday, May 12, 2025, at Oconee Memorial Hospital.

Born in Toccoa, GA, Mrs. Duvall was the daughter of the late William Franklin and Mary Stone Wall. To know her was to love her. Mrs. Duvall was a proud military wife for 22 years. She retired from Keowee Elementary school as the librarian and was a primary school teacher prior to that. Mrs. Duvall was a fantastic storyteller and a talented musician who played and taught the piano and organ, and also served as choir director.

In addition to her husband of 58 years, Mrs. Duvall is survived by her son: Edward Duvall (April); daughter: Jackie Cox (Jimmy); and grandchildren: Noah and Kara.

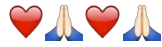

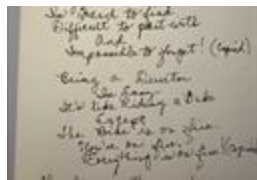
