Salem, SC--A bright light was extinguished from our lives with the death of "Sally" Sara Jane (Elliott) Foreman at home on Tuesday July 13, 2010, after a courageous and dignified battle with cancer.

Sally was born in Columbus, Ohio, on April 25, 1950, to Jack and Laura Elliott. She graduated from West Jefferson (Ohio) High School and attended Ohio University. In 1969, she married the love of her life, Bob Foreman. Over the years, Sally happily moved the family and household to Decatur, IL; Laurel, MD; and Roswell, GA, as Bob's career advanced. In 2000, Bob and Sally made Lake Keowee, outside Salem, SC, their home and have been active in the Keowee Key community and developed many close friendships. Sally enjoyed golf, bridge, travel, cooking, entertaining, and her volunteer work with Habitat for Humanity; but her greatest joy was her family, which she kept closely knit despite being separated geographically.
