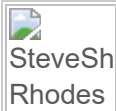

Scott impacted our family when our son had a car accident on a Saturday morning when Scott was a Paramedic. Scott got permission to ride to the hospital in Greenville with him. We were ever so thankful that he had a friend in that ambulance with him that day. He remembers Scott praying for him on the way over.

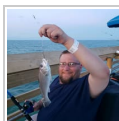
