



## Mrs. Sharon Miller Holcombe

April 29, 1946 - August 26, 2024

Sharon Miller Holcombe, 78, wife of the late Larry Winston Holcombe, of Seneca, passed away on Monday, August 26, 2024, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Asheville, NC, Mrs. Holcombe was the daughter of the late Arthur Lewis and Pauline Miller. Sharon worked at Caine Company Real Estate for 4 years and Simpkins Company Real Estate for 10 years. At both companies she was bookkeeper/accountant. When her children were in school, she volunteered in the school as a teacher assistant, then served as PTA President and Girl Scout Troop Leader. In addition to volunteering support in the schools, she volunteered once a week at church supporting various activities including creating the weekly bulletin, preparing the offerings for the bank, and completing the Sunday attendance forms. For the past year and half, she volunteered one day a week doing sales in back of store at Habitat for Humanity. As well as these paid and volunteer activities, over the past 40 years she served as teacher/leader/lecturer of various bible studies including Community Bible Study and Precept. This is the role that was most dear to her heart as it has allowed her to share the gospel with others. Mrs. Holcombe was of the Presbyterian faith.

Mrs. Holcombe is survived by her son: Byron Scott Warren Holcombe of Liberty, SC; daughter: Malane Ariane Holcombe of Alpharetta, GA; sister:

Marrissa Grindstaff; and four grandchildren: Christopher, Capri, Emma and Ronen.

In addition to her husband and parents, Mrs. Holcombe was preceded in death by her daughter: Sabrina Malane Holcombe; and sister: Annette Kirby.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:00 PM, Saturday, August 31, 2024, at New Hope Baptist Church with burial to follow at Evergreen Memorial Gardens.
