Verner Morris Wald, 85, husband of Ruth P. Wald, of West Union, passed away Thursday, May 16, 2013 at Cottingham Hospice House in Seneca.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Wald was the son of the late Diedrick D. and Susan Addis Wald and the last surviving member of his family. He retired from the Torrington Company and was a member and past deacon of the Mountain View Baptist Church. Mr. Wald served on the West Union City Council and was also Mayor Pro Tem of West Union.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Wald is survived by daughters: Brenda Lee and her husband Bobby of Seneca, Phyllis Phillips and her husband Phil of West Union; son: Curtis Wald and his wife Lori of West Union; six grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
