Walhalla, SC—Mr. Virgil Wallace “Wally” Lusk, 68, husband of Jerrie Bell Lusk, of Overlook Trail, Dallas, GA, died Tuesday, February 12, 2008 at his home after fighting cancer.

A native of Walhalla, SC, Mr. Lusk was the son of the late Danner David and Essie Inez Garrett Lusk. He and his wife, Jerrie, lived in Smyrna, GA where he served the community until he retired as Chief Master Sgt. at Dobbins Air Force Base. He served a total of 42 years with the US Air Force and Civil Service Unit with Top Secret clearance including the Air Force Reserve Unit. He served in a special military unit in the Persian Gulf War going to Desert Storm. He was a member of the Yaarab Shrine Center, Kennesaw Lodge 33, Entertainers Unit, Scottish Rite, and the Square & Compass Club. He coached baseball in Smyrna for 15 years, was President of Smyrna Boys Baseball, Pony League in the 1970’s and coached the Pony League State Champions and Colt League Southeast Allstars. He was Co-founder and Co-owner of Jonquil Sporting Goods and Roman Sporting Goods. There is a street named in his honor in the city of Smyrna. He was Former owner of United Motor Homes, Founder of Cobb Frame and Arts and Past President of South Eastern Region of Boys Baseball.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Lusk is survived by son, Tony Lusk; daughter, Cindy Bartlett; grandchildren, Robert Lusk, Richard Lusk, Trevor Bartlett and Micah

Bartlett; brother, Sonny Lusk; sisters, Judy Campbell and Madalyn Smith; and several nieces and nephews.
