



Mr. Warren Bryon Alexander

July 25, 1923 - October 31, 2014

Warren B. Alexander, 91, former general manager of operations for Michigan Bell Telephone Company in the northern part of the state, died Oct. 31 2014 in Seneca, SC.

Born on July 25, 1923, in Ecorse, MI, Mr. Alexander graduated from Ecorse High School in 1941. He was the coxswain of the championship rowing teams from the Ecorse Boat Club in 1940 and 1941. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. Following the war, he began a long career with Michigan Bell. After several managerial jobs in the Detroit area, he was appointed commercial manager, and later general manager, for the telephone company's operations in northern Michigan. He served as a president and long-time board member for the National Association of Investments Clubs (NAIC) and was active in several civic organizations. Following his retirement, Mr. Alexander lived in Tennessee, North Carolina and South Carolina.

He is survived by his wife, Dorothy; two sons: Rodger of Bloomington, IN and Randy of Littleton, CO; daughter: Ann Savino of Grand Rapids, MI; granddaughter: Jessica Barnett of Muskegon, MI; and two great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 AM Monday, November 17, 2014, at St. Francis Catholic Church in Walhalla, SC, with a luncheon at Oconee

Heritage Center to follow.
