He attended St. Luke United Methodist Church, coached girls basketball at the Walhalla Rec Center for over ten years, coached girls softball, served on the Rec Center Advisory Board for the last four years, had previously served as the Youth Director at Walhalla Presbyterian Church, was serving the youth at St. Luke's Methodist Church for the last twelve years, served with the Rotary Club, Sertoma Club, Lions Club, Octoberfest Committee, and The Walhalla Chamber of Commerce Board.
