



William "Buster" Furman Wilson

William Furman "Buster" Wilson, 84, formerly of Salem and Seneca, SC, was twice married, first to the late Ruth Crenshaw Wilson and then to the late Nioma Stephens Eades Wilson. He died Easter Sunday, April 8, 2012 at Rainey Hospice House, Anderson, SC.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Wilson was also born on Easter Sunday, April 8, 1928. He was the youngest child of the late William Beattie and Florence Ragsdale Wilson. He was retired from farming and from J P Stevens with 36 years of service, and later returned to work in the security field. He was a member of Fall Creek Baptist Church where he previously served as a Deacon and song leader for many years. Mr. Wilson was also a member of the Blue Ridge Masonic Lodge # 92.
